Competition Schedule

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Competition Schedule

1. Master class

To enter this section you must have won a “Gold” award (in any class) at any major competition - i.e. British Sugarcraft Guild, Cake International, Salon Culinaire, Llancaiach Fawr or similar.

£2 per entry.

Master Class A : Freestyle sugarcraft

Theme: Myths & Legends

Cakes, cake dummies, floristry wires, stamens, thread, ribbon and floristry tape are allowed. Cold porcelain is not permitted.

Exhibit to fit within a 24 inch square. No height restriction.

£2 per entry.

Master Class B: Floral arrangement

Theme: Flowers for a wedding

Arrangement of flowers, buds and foliage made from any edible medium.

The arrangement may be presented on a suitable base or in a container. Exhibit to fit within a 12 inch square. No height restriction.

Wires, stamens, thread, ribbon and floristry tape are allowed. Cold porcelain is not permitted.

2. Open

This section is open to everyone, but you may not enter a class in which you have previously won "Gold" at a major competition.

Open Class C: Floral - a single rose

A single rose with stem and leaves.

The rose may be presented on a suitable base or in a container. The exhibit to fit within a 6 inch square. No height restriction. Please include a note showing the rose variety being exhibited.

Edible dusting powders may be used to create a natural and realistic appearance. Edible glazes may be used, but must be displayed with the exhibit. Wires, stamens and floristry tape are allowed. No other artificial decoration, cold porcelain or glitter permitted.

Open Class D: Baking - a rich fruit cake

A round rich fruit cake, 8 inches in diameter weighing approximately 2 kg, presented on a 10 inch round cake board.

Each cake will be cut and tasted. The recipe for the cake must be provided in a sealed envelope which will be opened only by the judging panel.

Open Class E: Floral arrangement

Theme: Open

Arrangement of flowers, buds and foliage made from any edible medium.

The arrangement may be presented on a suitable base or in a container. Exhibit to fit within an 8 inch square. No height restriction.

Wires, stamens, thread, ribbon and floristry tape are allowed. Cold porcelain is not permitted.

Open Class F: Tiered cake

Theme: A celebration

A display of more than one tier of cake. May be covered with any edible medium.

To fit within a 16 inch square. No height restriction. Cake dummies permitted. Supports may be used.

Open Class G: Decorated picture

Theme: Nursery rhymes

A picture made from any edible medium, showing any skill of the competitor's choosing - e.g. bas relief, brush embroidery, appliqué, painting, etc.

Exhibit to fit within a 6 inch square with a height restriction of 2 inches (measured from table top to the highest part of the exhibit). A cake board or card may be used but will form part of the height restriction.

Open Class H: "Non edible pastes"

Theme: A summer's day

A decorative piece / flowers / models made from Artista Soft / Cold Porcelain / Modena.

To fit within a 12 inch square. No height restriction. Cake dummies permitted. Supports may be used. Wires, stamens, thread, ribbon and floristry tape are allowed.

3. Novice

This section is intended for beginners to sugarcraft and who have never previously won a prize at a major cake competition.

Novice Class I: Baking - a sponge cake

A sponge cake presented on a china plate or cake stand.

Plain sponge consisting of two layers with a filling of your choice - cream permitted. No coverings or decoration allowed - except for a dusting of sugar. Cakes will be cut and tasted.

Novice Class J: Novelty cake - a single tier

Theme: Music

A single tiered cake, covered with any edible medium. All decorations must be edible.

To fit within a 12 inch square. No height restriction. Cake dummies permitted.

£2 per entry.

Novice Class K: Models

Theme: Fairy tales / fantasy

A single or range of models, made from any edible medium.

Exhibit to fit within a 12 inch square, no height restriction. Internal supports may be used but should not be obvious. Non-toxic gold, silver, glitter, glazes or paints may be used but must be displayed with the exhibit.

The exhibit is intended to be viewed from all sides, so the back of the exhibit must also be completed.

Novice Class L: Floral arrangement

Theme: Summer

Arrangement of flowers, buds and foliage made from any edible medium.

The arrangement may be presented on a suitable base or in a container. Exhibit to fit within a 6 inch square. No height restriction.

Wires, stamens, thread, ribbon and floristry tape are allowed. Cold porcelain is not permitted.

4. Group

Class M: Group entry

Theme: Mansions & Gardens.

A display of sugarcraft work by members of a group. The exhibit should show a range of skills and there should not be more than 50% of any one skill on display – eg. 50% floral displays

All work must be original and not have been previously exhibited. The display must fit within a 6' x 2' space. No height restriction.

5. Junior

Junior Class N: Under 10 years old

Theme: Wales

A selection of six homemade cupcakes showing at least two different designs.

Cupcakes to be presented on a suitable plate/platter and should be similar in shape and size. All decoration must be edible. Cakes will not be cut and tasted. Exhibit to fit within a 10 inch square. No height restriction on exhibit. Competitor's age (not name) must be displayed with the exhibit.

Competitors must be under 10 years old on the day of the competition.

No entry free.

Junior Class O: 10 to 16 years old

Theme: Hobbies

A single tiered cake, covered with any edible medium.

Cakes will not be cut and tasted. Exhibit to fit within a 12 inch square. No height restriction on exhibit. Cake dummies permitted. Competitor's age (not name) must be displayed with the exhibit.

Competitors must be between the ages of 10 to 16 years old on the day of the competition.
